TOP PICKS – ART BASEL AND BEYOND

With more than 250 participating galleries, art enthusiasts can take in the best of the best during and many after Art Basel, as recommended by Claire Breukel, curator for *Unscripted* Bal Harbour. Born in South Africa, Breukel began her career curating the 2002 Cape Town Month of Photography biennale and the Vision Photography Festival before being introduced to Miami by the Rubell Family Collection.

1. Locust Projects features Daniel Arsham and Simón Vega

Don't miss exhibitions by renowned Miami-born architect and artist Daniel Arsham (of Snarkitecture) and El Salvador's 2013 Venice Biennale artist Simón Vega. Both artists challenge conventions of space and social practice, which will undoubtedly offer a daring and exciting experience. www.locustprojects.org

2. Peter Marino's "One Way" at the Bass Museum of Art.

Architect, designer and leather-wearing fashion icon Peter Marino is known for the unapologetic melding of disciplines in his work. Following this mantra, "One Way" exhibits a combination of Marino's artwork, architectural designs, and other artists from his collection of contemporary art. 3. Ping Pong in Miami

This tri-city nomadic exhibition is a conversation between artists from Switzerland, Miami and Los Angeles that highlights both the similarities and disparities between living experiences. 4. Fairchild Tropical Gardens features Satyendra Pakhale's "40 Fish Chairs"

Don't miss the exhibition of "40 Fish Chairs" by industrial designer and architect Satyendra Pakhale curated by Cristina Grajales. Forty chairs have been produced by Pakhale and Cappellini in an Aquamarine color, to reference to their close proximity to the ocean. 5. Rubell Family Collection

Each year collectors Mera and Don Rubell and Director Juan Valadez curate an exhibition that is an in-depth exploration of a region's artistic practice or a topical theme. This year the theme is "personal" promising an exhibition of the collection's most exceptional highlights. rfc.museum

6. American Scene Photography from the Martin Z. Margulies collection

The selection of photographs that make up *American Scene Photography* explores the human condition across a variety of time periods, and showcases America's best historical, documentary and contemporary photographers, including Berenice Abbott, Weegee, William Eggleston, as well as Cindy Sherman, Gregory Crewdson, Miles Coolidge, Alec Soth, and many more. www.moafl.org

7. Primary Projects "International Friendship Exhibition"

Although the title sounds sentimental, the exhibition featuring Autumn Casey, Kenton Parker, Reed Von Brunschot, Cody Hudson, Magnus Sodamin, Asif Farooq, Andrew Nigon and many more, will most certainly not be. The description for the exhibition is filled innuendo and reads as follows: "Off the balcony, I see the most glorious scene in the world. This exhibition stands here, It's tattered perfection, turned on ear, exalts the dignity that is primary. The ocean never looked bluer, the dreamers are within reach."

9. HOTBED in The Yard at CasaLin

Partnering for a second year with HOTBED, a long-term initiative by Wet Heat Project, Lin Lougheed's annual exhibition at his outdoor art space CasaLin features the best of New World School of the Arts students and alumni.
